Project: Enabling the 2030 Agenda through education for sustainable development IN-PERSON Kick-off meeting, Tuesday 26th APRIL 2022

The in-person kick-off meeting of the project Enabling the 2030 Agenda through education for sustainable development (www.tenforsustainability.eu/AGENDA2030.html) has been held on Tuesday 26th April 2022 in Ascoli Piceno (Italy), with participants from the following organizations: Ten For Sustainability (Project Applicant and Coordinator, Italy), Neotalentway (Spain), Interfusion Services Limited (Cyprus), Vardakeios School of indigent children (Greece), Mobilizing Expertise Ab (Sweden). The project is co-financed by the Erasmus+program of the European Union.

The project stems from the perspective of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and especially of its Sustainable Development Goal n° 4, targeting inclusive and equitable quality education and lifelong learning opportunities for all, as pivotal in building sustainable, inclusive and resilient societies.

The exchange of good practice was based, among others, on the following topics:

- training of people to favor their access in the labour market and entrepreneurship and the development of other key competences.
- the role of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development in shaping the educational environments of tomorrow based on a complete and holistic training experience for educators/trainers/staff.

We'd like to highlight the following outcomes:

a) the main dimensions of sustainability (adaptation, mitigation, Neutralization = Decarbonisation, Resilience), are relevant to adult education, to train and upskill, reskill trainers and learners, in the following spheres:

Being aware of ecological footprint

Teaching to enable transformation and be relevant in the labour marketing

How sustainability can touch emotional/behavioural intelligence

b) potential answers to environmental issues have no perfect solutions, satisfying all stakeholders in full (Pareto efficient solutions), transparency of benefits/costs for all involved stakeholders is key to "negotiate" possible applicable solutions.

Artificial intelligence VS synthetic intelligence, could be a cornerstone for humanity in looking for the most efficient solutions when different conflicting interests are at stake: better educated people can make better decisions.

The remaining two transnational project meetings will be held in Lund (Sweden) on Monday 27th of June and in Granada (Spain) on Monday 4th of July.
